ForestOne is Australia's largest independent distributor of plywood, timber, laminate and decorative surface materials. Since its inception under the Gunnersen brand over 140 years ago, ForestOne has been a major player in the building industry, providing excellent service, supplying materials for building and interior decor nationwide. Fortude supported ForestOne to revive a troubled Infor M3 implementation. From conducting extensive research into ForestOne's business requirements to ensuring the successful migration of data from their legacy system, Fortude provided the customer with on-site expertise to ensure a smooth transition and go-live. Fortude also enabled the integration of Electronic Data Interchange (EDI) with its ecosystem to eliminate manual data entry related to purchase orders and customer orders. The implementation was completed within a time frame of 18 months.

Challenges

- A troubled Infor M3 implementation that had some significant setbacks and did not have a clear go live time frame due to various issues.
- Complicated exchange rates issues arising from imported products, and the requirement for highly customized delivery dockets and a technically sound warehousing operation with mobility requirements.

Solution

Fortude met the company's requirements of providing an onsite Infor M3 expert to educate stakeholders on the process of Infor M3 implementation, long-term onsite experts to troubleshoot, and industry experts who were able to better customize the solution to suit the business.

IEC was also set up to convert M3 data into the EDIFACT format and these are sent to suppliers and customers. Using IEC, invoices received from suppliers are also updated on M3. |
